

Patchwork Cushion

Cut six strips of different fabrics 7.5cm x 42cm

Cut two rectangles 24cm x 42cm for the back

You will need a 35cm Zip



- Sew all the strips together with the edge of the foot on the edge of the fabric.
- Sew the two backs together with a 2cm (important 2cm) seam allowance leaving a hole in the middle the length of the zip. Then press open.
- Pin the right side of the zip to the right side of the fabric pushing the teeth into the groove that you ironed in.
- Sew using your zipper foot (undo zip halfway down so that you don't have to sew past the bump)
- Pin the second side and sew across the end and then down the side and across the bottom
Make sure you have caught the zip underneath.
Undo zip
- Pin the front and back of cushion together with right sides together.
- Sew around the edge pivoting on each corner
- Turn your cushion through
