### Fabric Tray to Sew

These Fabric trays are great for keeping jewellery, hair ties and hair clips in. When made larger they make fantastic bread baskets for the table. What a fun idea to sew as gifts for Mum or Aunties.

You will need Two Squares or rectangles of fabric that are the same size. Both squares can be in the same fabric or you might like to try contrasting.

The size can be up to you or a good size for small is 25 cm or large 35cm

Place both fabrics right sides together and stitch all the way around the outside edge leaving a small gap of 4cm for you to turn the square through. This is a 6mm seam, so line the edge of the fabric against the edge of the foot just like we do in class.

Turn Fabric through and press now top stitch all the way around the edge making sure you stitch the gap closed.



Fold Square in half diagonally and draw a line down 6 cm from point on small Square or 11 cm on large square. Then sew making sure to reverse at each end. Then repeat to each corner.

Ta Da, all done enjoy
